On about Sept. 1, 1947 plan to run approximately 2810' of 7" O. D. used 24" Lapweld casing and cement same with 100 sacks of cement preceded by mud using Haliburton Oil Well Cementing equipment.

After waiting 48 hours for cement to set plan to drill plug, bail hole dry and make 4 hour bailing test to determine water shut off.
