Detailed account of work done, nature and quantity of materials used and results obtained.

This well has been producing since December 1951 from the Premier sand at 3102 to 3110' through a Halliburton D.C. packer set at 3070'. The well has declined to approx. 3 bbls. of oil per day. We plugged off the packer and put in a calseal bridge from 2925 to 2907'. We then treated the Loco Hills sand at 2871 to 2883' with 10,000 gal. oil and 15,000# sand. After the well returned the lead oil it made 130 bbls. in 24 hrs. on gas lift. The 5 1/2" O.D. casing is set and cemented in this well at 2796'.
