As per application filed on April 30, 1973, for the re-entry of the subject well and completion as a Grayburg producing well, Armer Oil Company has attempted to re-enter this well with cable tools. After reaching a depth of approximately 1750', a string of cable tools were lost in the hole and these tools subsequently fell to a depth of 2230'. Efforts to fish these tools failed. We propose to plug this well as per the Rules and Regulations of the USGS and New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission and move to a location 330' due West of the Arnold "F" #1 to drill a new well. 180 FOOT CEMENT PLUGS WILL BE SET AT 2000-2100', 1250-1350', 450-550', AND A 20 FOOT SURFACE PLUG, HEAVY MUD BETWEEN ALL PLUGS AND A REGULATION MARKER INSTALLED, THE LOCATION WILL BE CLEANED AND LEVELED TO ORIGINAL CONTOUR.
