OLD TOTAL DEPTH: 3434'.DEEPEST ZONE TESTED: Premier Sand from 3299'-3312'.CASING NOW IN HOLE: 10-3/4" OD casing set at 571' and cemented with 50 sacks cement.WATER ZONES: None from 10-3/4" OD casing seat to present total depth.HOLE REDUCED AT: 3180' from 8" to 6-1/4".MISCELLANEOUS NOTES: 10-3/4" OD surface casing was originally set in this hole so that in the event that the shallow pay zones were barren and a 7" production string of casing was not run this hole would be in shape to drill deeper should deeper oil pays be indicated in this area in the future.
