This well was drilled to a total depth of 3390' where 5 bailers per hour of water was encountered. We propose to plug as follows; 15 sack cement plug at 3390', mud back to base of the salt at 1465' where a 10 sack cement plug will be set, then mudded back to bottom of 8 5/8" casing at 500' and a 5 sack cement plug, then mudded to surface and regulation marker set and cemented.
