1. Pull rods and tubing, check total depth with sand pump.
2. Run collar log, perforate middle Matex Zone at 2,424'-2,428' and 2,432'-2,440' with 2 shots/ft.
3. Frac new perforations with 10,000 gallons treated brine and 10,000 lbs. sand spear headed with 500 gallons 15% HC/acid.
4. Run rods and tubing, place well back on production status.
