On July 4, 1967, cemented 8 5/8" 24# J55 casing at 541' with 200 sacks Incor cement with 2% CaCl. Cement failed to circulate. Casing was tested with 500 psi for 30 minutes and pressure held.

On July 27, 1967, cemented 4 1/2" OD. 9.6# J-55 casing at 3513 with 225 sacks Incor cement. Found top of cement at 2710' behind casing. Casing was pressure tested with 1500 psi for 30 minutes and pressure held.

Instructions

Any necessary special instructions concerning the use of this form and the number of copies to be submitted, particularly with regard to local, area, or regional procedures and practices, either are shown below or will be issued by, or may be obtained from, the local Federal and/or State office.
