Drilled with cable tools to TB 3552'. Ran G&W logs, set loggers packer at 3290 and fracture treated well down 2 1/2" tubing with 45,000 gal. gelled water and 54,000# 20-40 sand in three stages separated w/500 gal brine and 500# rock salt plugs. Each stage preceded with 500 gal 15% Hcl. Avg. 25-7 B/W @ 3500 psi. ISDP 1400, 15 min. 1350. Pulled tubing and packer, ran 2" production tubing, washed well out to TB, ran rods & pump. Set pumping unit and put well on pump.

Instructions

General: This form is designed for submitting proposals to perform certain well operations, and reports of such operations when completed, as indicated, on Federal and Indian lands pursuant to applicable Federal law and regulations, and, if approved or accepted by any State, on all lands in such State, pursuant to applicable State law and regulations. Any necessary special instructions concerning the use of this form and the number of copies to be submitted, particularly with regard to local, area, or regional procedures and practices, either are shown below or will be issued by, or may be obtained from, the local Federal and/or State office.

Item 4: If there are no applicable State requirements, locations on Federal or Indian land should be described in accordance with Federal requirements. Consult local State or Federal office for specific instructions.
