Drilled to 2878 TD. Ran GR - Density Log, set 5 1/2" 14# casing @ 2878', cemented with 450 sacks Class C, Pozmix 25 Gal 8# salt/w. Let cement set 72 hours. Perforated 2651-58, 2702-06, 2741-44, 2746-49, 2771-80, 2847-51, 2856-60. Ran 2 1/2" tubing with Straddle Packers, treated each zone with 1000 gallons acid, 35,000 gallons gelled water, 35,000# sand.

Perfs 2847-60, treated 30 BPM @ 4300 PSL, ISIP 1450#, 15 min. 1400#.

Perfs 2771-80) treated 29 BPM @ 4400 PSL, ISIP 1800#, 15 min. 1400#.

Perfs 2741-49) treated 26 BPM @ 3900 PSL, ISIP 1600#, 15 min. 1450#.

Perfs 2702-06, treated 25 BPM @ 4000 PSL, ISIP 1900#, 15 min. 1450#.

Pulled tubing and packers, ran production tubing, washed well out, ran rods and pump, set pumping unit and put well on production on 6-1-72.

Instructions

General: This form is designed for submitting proposals to perform certain well operations, and reports of such operations when completed, as indicated, on Federal and Indian lands pursuant to applicable Federal law and regulations, and, if approved or accepted by any State, on all lands in such State, pursuant to applicable State law and regulations. Any necessary special instructions concerning the use of this form and the number of copies to be submitted, particularly with regard to local, area, or regional procedures and practices, either are shown below or will be issued by, or may be obtained from, the local Federal and/or State office.
