Drilled to TD 3002'. Ran GR Density Logs, set 5 1/2" 14# casing @ 2980', cemented with 450 sacks Class C Pozzolan, 2% Gel, 2% salt/sk. Let cement set 72 hours. Perforated Grayburg zones 2702-14', 2806-20', 2883-24', 2930-46'. Treated each interval with 1000 gallons acid, 35,000 gallons gelled water and 35,000# sand. Equipped well with tubing, rods and pump. Set pumping equipment and put well on production on June 28, 1972.

Instructions

Any necessary special instructions concerning the use of this form and the number of copies to be submitted, particularly with regard to local, area, or regional procedures and practices, either are shown below or will be issued by, or may be obtained from, the local Federal and/or State office.
