We Propose to drill this well approximately 3600' and complete in the Grayburg and San Andres. All zones indicating porosity will be acidized or sand frac. Well will be either drilled with air or water. If drilled with air, a control head will be used. If drilled with water and native mud, the hole will be mudded up 100' from TD to clean hole for logging and a 10" blowout Preventer will be used.

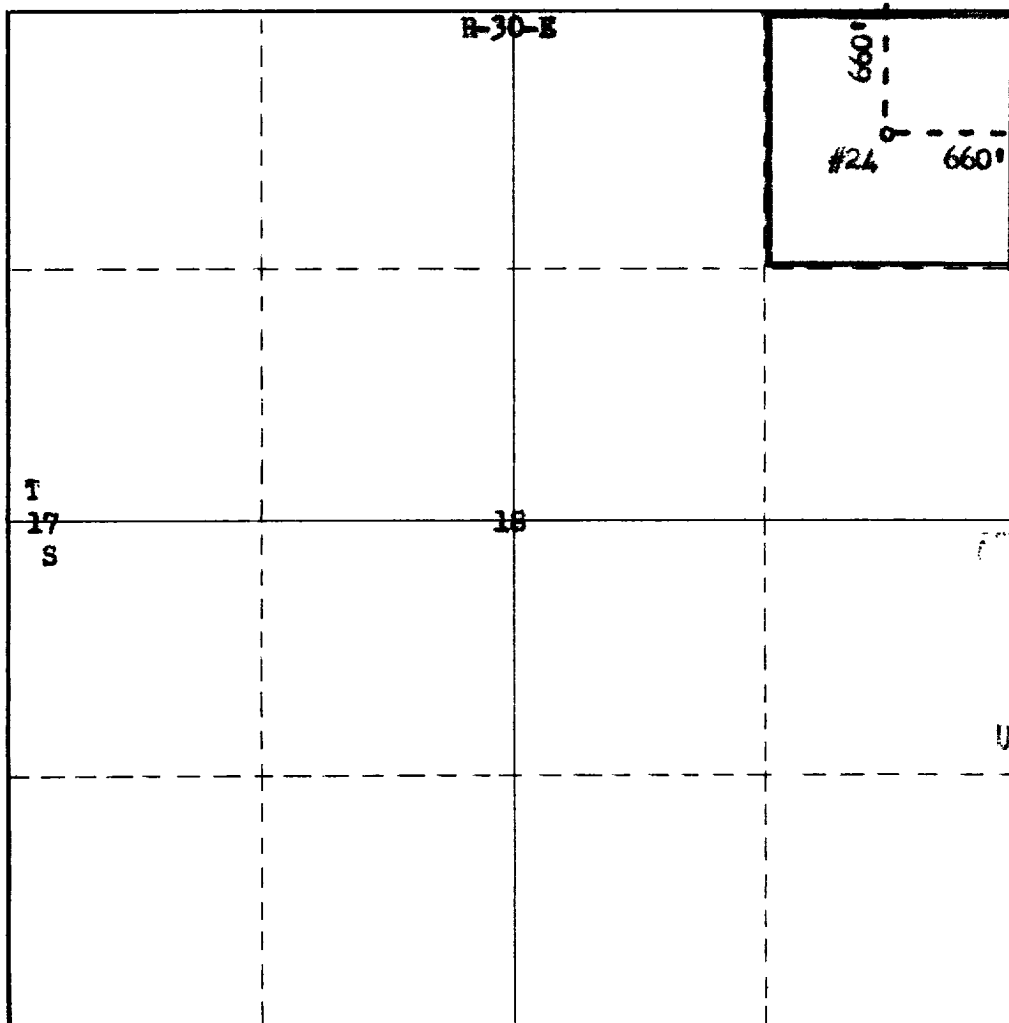

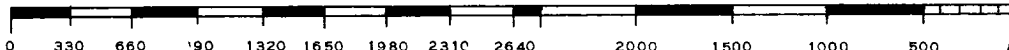
