1. Rig up pulling unit. TOH with packer and tubing.
2. WIH with Retrievable Bridge Plug and packer. Established hole in 4½" casing between 468' and 473'. TOH.
3. Ran free point and found casing Free to 1765'. Made back off at 1700'. Could move casing up 12' but no higher. Screwed casing back together. Backed off at 983'. Could move casing up 12' but no higher. Could not screw casing back together.
4. Set CIBP at 2700' and perforate 4 squeeze holes at 1340'. (150' below salt section)
5. WIH with packer and cemented out squeeze holes with 60 sx Class H with 2% CaCl. Perforations squeezed off at 2000' before all cement out perfs. TOH.
6. Sanded back across separation at 983'.
7. Cement down 4½" casing and out holes between 468' and 473' with 150 sx Class H with 2% CaCl. Did not circulate cement.
8. Ran bit and drill out cement and cleaned out to CIBP at 2700'. TOH.
9. Ran CBL from 2700' to surface. Showed cement from 2700' to 1796', 1338' to 1336', and 474' to 424'.
10. Perforated 4 squeeze holes at 1310'. (120' below salt)
11. WIH with packer and cemented out perforations with 60 sx Class H with 2% CaCl. TOH.
12. Set Retrievable Bull Plug at 450'. Perforated 4 squeeze holes at 418'.
13. Established circulation down 4½" casing to surface. Cement with 50 sx lite cement with 3% CaCl and tailed in with 50 sx Class H with 2% CaCl. Circulate 25 sx to pit.
14. WIH with bit drill cement. TOH. Retrieved RBP. WIH with bit and drill out cement and cleaned out to CIBP at 2700'. TOH.

Instructions

General: This form is designed for submitting proposals to perform certain well operations, and reports of such operations when completed, as indicated, on Federal and Indian lands pursuant to applicable Federal law and regulations, and, if approved or accepted by any State, on all lands in such State, pursuant to applicable State law and regulations. Any necessary special instructions concerning the use of this form and the number of copies to be submitted, particularly with regard to local, area, or regional procedures and practices, either are shown below or will be issued by, or may be obtained from, the local Federal and/or State office.

Item 4: If there are no applicable State requirements, locations on Federal or Indian land should be described in accordance with Federal requirements. Consult local State or Federal office for specific instructions.

Item 17: Proposals to abandon a well and subsequent reports of abandonment should include such special information as is required by local Federal and/or State offices.
