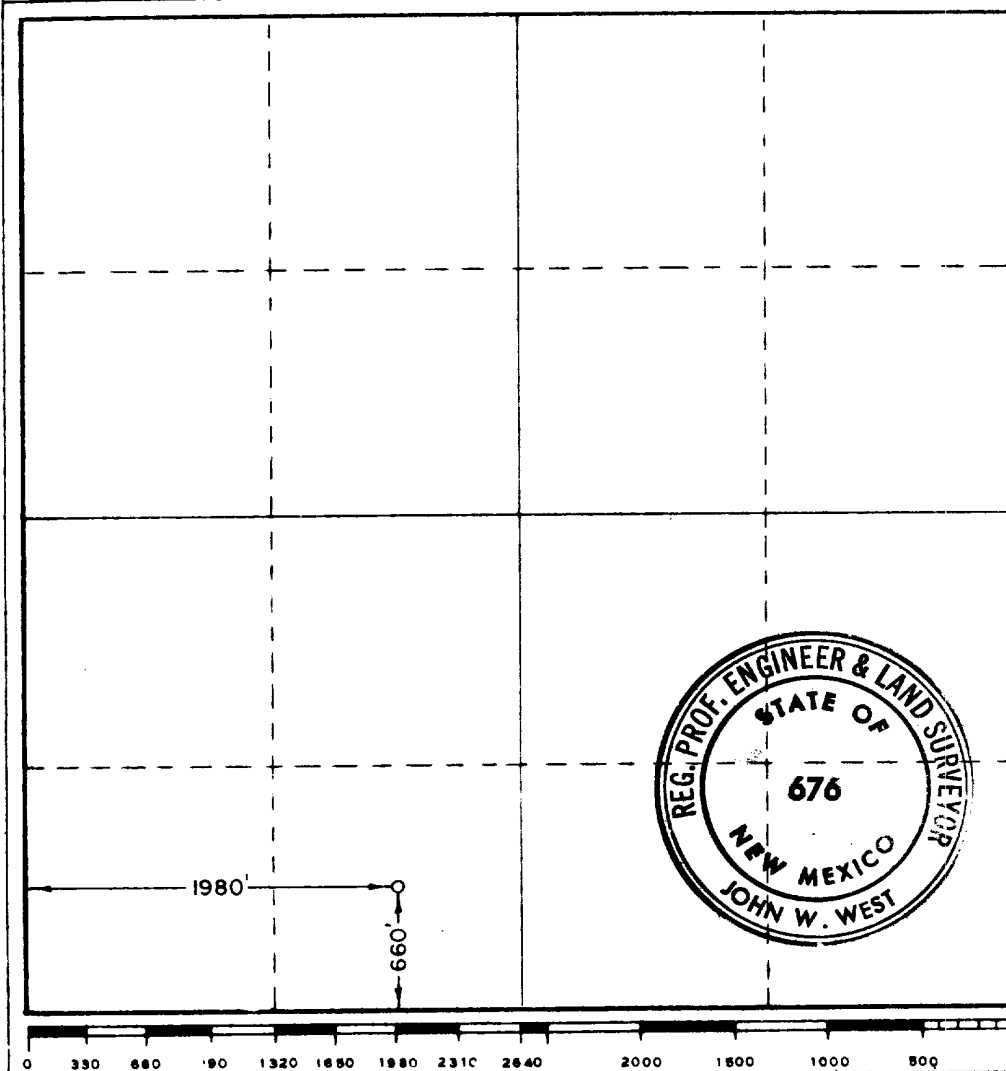

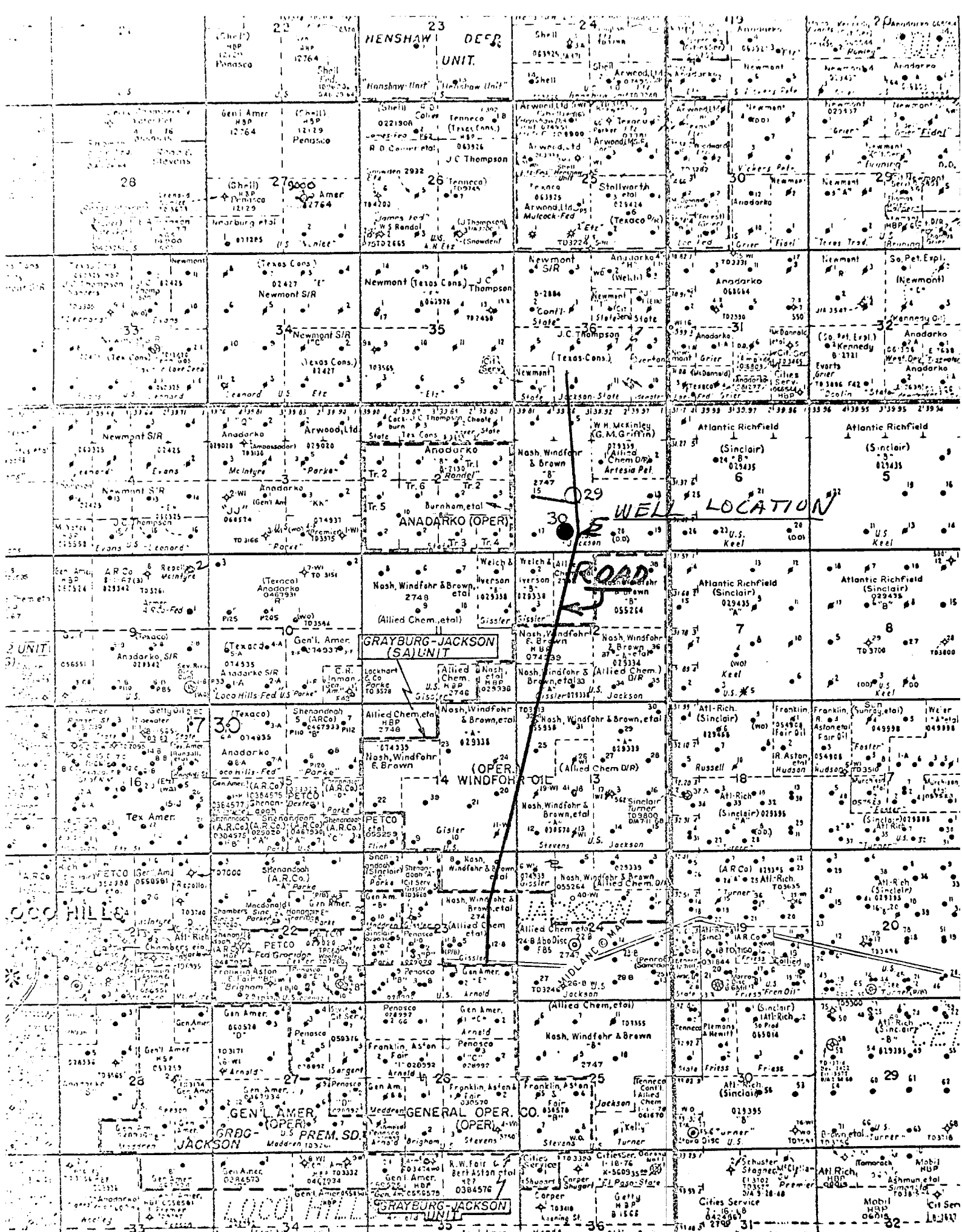

- (1) Existing roads are shown by solid red lines on the attached map. In the immediate proximity of the proposed location.
- (2) The location falls near an existing county road and only a short road will be necessary.
- (3) Locations of existing wells are shown on the attached map.
- (4) Lateral roads to well locations are covered by 11 and 12 above.
- (5) 12 will be piped to the existing tank battery.
- (6) Water will be purchased at Jumbo Hill, New Mexico, and needed to rig, or will be piped from existing water line located in the area.
- (7) The method for handling all waste disposed will be a waste pit at the battery, to be covered up after drilling is completed.
- (8) Location of camp - same.
- (9) Location of servicing - same.
- (10) The drilling rig layout will be as shown on the attached plan. The drilling pad will be compacted caliche.
- (11) Plans for restoration of the surface include filling and leveling of all pits.
- (12) Other information - The proposed location is in the corner of a well land lease covered with weeds, brush, and small mesquite. No cattle or horses are in the vicinity of the proposed drilling site.
