This Unit well has developed a hole in the production casing. We propose to dig a working pit, if needed, locate & repair hole or holes in 5.1/2" production casing. After testing the existing perforated intervals(3018' - 3024' & 3289' - 3293') we propose to add additional perforations from 3046' - 3185' & 3307' - 3309' in the Vacuum and Lovington intervals of the San Andres formation. We then propose to stimulate all open perforation from 3018' to 3309' and return well to an active GJSAU pumping oil well.
