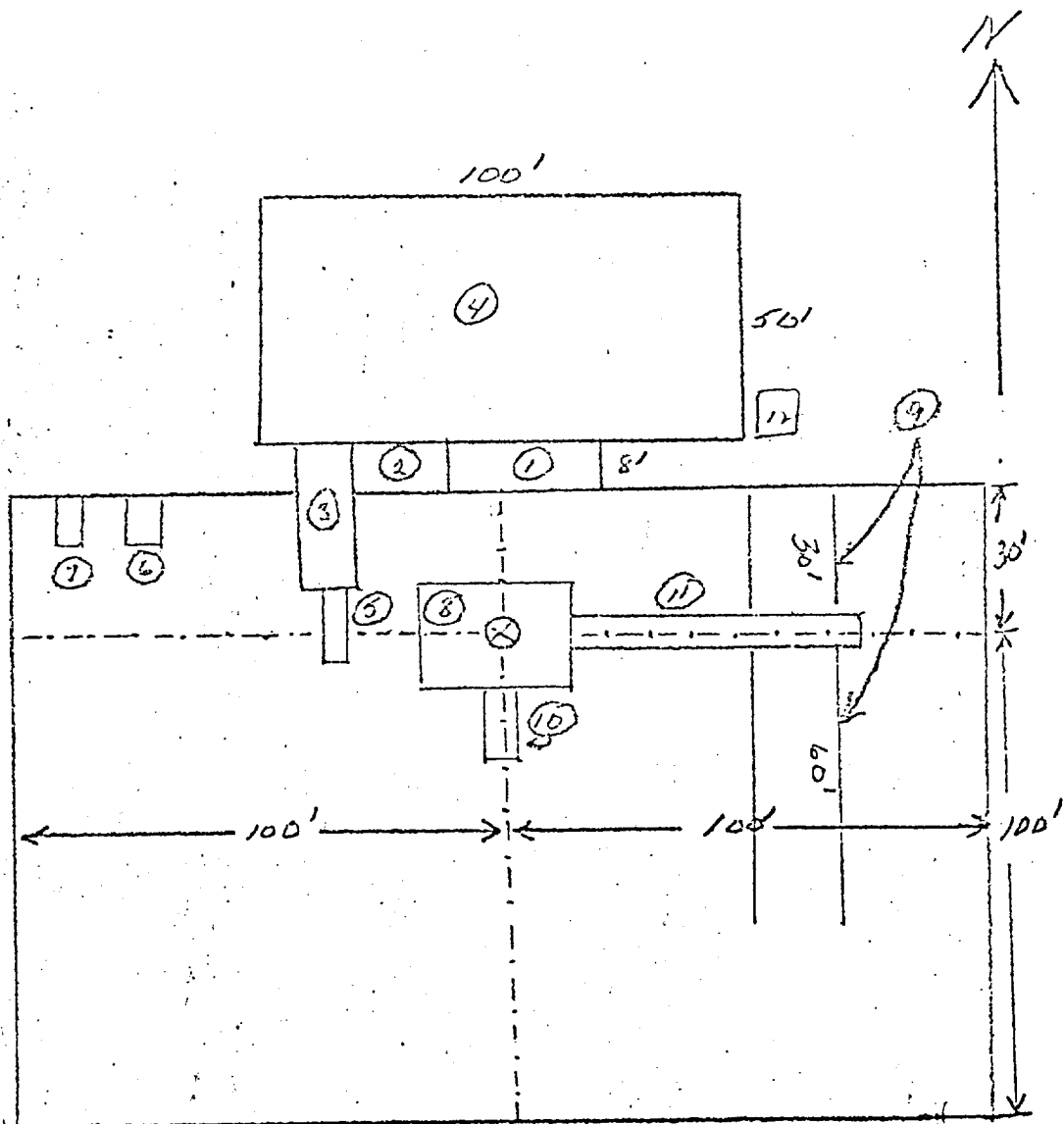
Following is the Development Plan for Surface Use in Association with the Application to Drill the Windfohr Oil Company - Grayburg Jackson (San Andres) Unit well #43, to be located 25' FSL and 1345' FWL, Section 13, Township 17 South, Range 30 East, Eddy County, New Mexico.

- (1) Existing roads are shown by solid red lines on the attached map, in the immediate proximity of the proposed location.
- (2) The location falls near an existing lease road and approximately 1585' of caliche road will be built.
- (3) Locations of existing wells are shown on the attached map.
- (4) Lateral roads to well locations are covered by (1) and (2) above.
- (5) Oil will be piped to the existing tank battery.
- (6) Water will be purchased at Loco Hills, New Mexico and hauled to the rig site, and will be piped from existing waterflood lines in the area.
- (7) The method for handling all waste disposal will be a small waste pit at the location, to be covered up after drilling is completed.
- (8) Location of camps - None.
- (9) Location of airstrip - None.
- (10) The drilling rig layout will be as shown on the attached plat. The drilling pad will be compacted caliche.
- (11) Plans for restoration of the surface includes filling and leveling of all pits.
- (12) Other information - The proposed location is in flat country with small sand dunes covered with weeds, yucca, and small mesquites. No gullies or arroyos are in the vicinity of the proposed drilling site.
