ORDER OF THE DIVISION

BY THE DIVISION:

This cause came on for hearing at 9 a.m. on February 14, 1979, at Santa Fe, New Mexico, before Examiner Daniel S. Nutter.

NOW, on this 26th day of June, 1979, the Division Director, having considered the testimony, the record, and the recommendations of the Examiner, and being fully advised in the premises,

FINDS:

(1) That due public notice having been given as required by law, the Division has jurisdiction of this cause and the subject matter thereof.

(2) That the applicant, Harvey E. Yates Company, seeks a determination by the Division, in accordance with Sections 2(c) and 102 of the Natural Gas Policy Act of 1978, and the applicable rules of the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission, that its Empire South Deep Unit Well No. 13, located in Unit N of Section 30, Township 17 South, Range 29 East, NMPM, Eddy County, New Mexico, has discovered a new onshore reservoir from which natural gas was not produced in commercial quantities before April 20, 1977.

(3) That said well was completed in an upper Morrow sand designated by the applicant as the "B-4 Sand" on April 7, 1977, with perforations from 10,665 feet to 10,677 feet, and a plugged-back depth of 10,960 feet after having been drilled to a total depth of 11,060 feet.

(4) That said well was first connected to a gas transmission facility on July 26, 1977.
