This well was fraced with 82,000 gallons of Redi-frac and was completed March 17, 1977, pumping 13 barrels of oil + 40 barrels of load water per day. Water production has declined to 10 $\frac{1}{2}$ barrels per day, and we believe this to be load fluid, but recovery of all the load fluid is at a slow rate. Water is temporarily being put into a surface pit. In view of the slow recovery rate, we are requesting an extension of time to continue testing well and recovering load fluid for a period of 60 to 90 days.

Instructions
