1. Rigged up rotary tools, spudded 17 1/2" hole @ 5:15 P.M. 6/28/78.
2. Drilled to 420'; set 419' of 13-3/8", 48# H-40 casing; cemented with 450 sx Class C w/2% CaCL. PD @ 2:30 P.M. 6/29/78. Circulated 131 sx to pit. WOC 24 hours. Cement settled around casing - dumped 4 yds of redimix w/2% CaCL down backside of casing which brought cement back to surface.
3. Installed 12" Shaffer Type B Hydraulic BOP 3000 psi, 10" GK Hydrill 3000 psi & 3000 WP Choke manifold. Tested BOP to 1500# prior to drilling cement.
4. Drilled 12 1/2" hole to 3500'. Encountered water flow of 1000 BWPD. Ran Vannoy Co. Temperature Survey which located water flow from 2990' - 3020' (Grayburg formation) but was unable to log below 3260' due to a bridge. The only good drilling break detected was from 3265' - 3270' (Grayburg) which also might have been producing water.
5. Ran 65 joints (3498') of K-55 (24#), S-80 (24#) and S-80 (28#) casing. Spotted DV Tool @ 3105' for 3 stage cementing job.
6. Cemented 1st stage from 3500' - 3105' w/100 sx Halliburton Lite w/5# Gilsontite/sx, 5# salt/sx & 1/4# Flocele/sx. & 200 sx Class C w/2% CaCL. PD @ 4:00 AM 7/10/78. Cementing witnessed by James Brasfield with U.S.G.S. Circulated 8 hours through DV tool while WOC.
7. Cemented 2nd stage from 3105' - 1290' w/450 sx Halliburton Lite w/5# Gilsontite/sx, 5# salt/sx & 1/4# Flocele/sx & tailed in w/200 sx Class H w/3% CaCL. Completed 2nd stage @ 1:30 PM 7/10/78. WOC 12 hours while flowing waterflow through DV tool.
8. Squeeze cemented 3rd stage through DV tool w/200 sx Class H w/3% CaCL. Maximum surface pressure = 2600#. PD @ 2:30 AM 7/11/78. WOC 12 hours w/well shut in.
