1. Set Halliburton cement retainer in 8-5/8" casing @ 2800'. Squeezed salt/sx below retainer into collapsed or parted casing @ 2927' & from 3130' - 3279' to shut off 1000 BPD waterflow from the Grayburg formation.
2. Freepointed 8-5/8" casing @ 1290'. McCullough shot with Jet bit but could not pull. Shot collar with string shot @ 1233' and parted casing @ 1233' & 1290' (parted casing @ 1233' & 1290' inside 8-5/8" casing stub & 50' above stub).
3. Halliburton spotted 60 sx Class H w/3% CaCL from 1316' - 1183' (inside 8-5/8" casing stub & 50' above stub).
4. Spotted 90 barrels of 9.7#/gal brine water w/9 sx brinegel in 12 1/2" cased hole from 1183' to 469'.
5. Spotted 75 sx Class H w/3% CaCL from 469' - 369' (50' below & 50' above 8-5/8" csg. shoe).
6. Spotted 40 barrels 9.7#/gal brine water w/4 sx brinegel in 13-3/8" cased hole between plug @ surface casing shoe and plug @ surface.
7. Spotted 20 sx Class H w/3% CaCL from 20' to surface on 7/18/78 @ 7:30 A.M.
8. Erected P&A marker. Temporarily cut off P&A marker in order to extend the reserve pit over this location. Marker will be re-erected as soon as the rig has been skidded 65' South of current location and the new well is completed.

Note: Notified Mr. James Brasfield with U. S. G. S., Artesia, N. M. prior to Plugging & Abandoning well.

Instructions

General: This form is designed for submitting proposals to perform certain well operations, and reports of such operations when completed, as indicated, on Federal and Indian lands pursuant to applicable Federal law and regulations, and, if approved or accepted by any State, on all lands in such State, pursuant to applicable State law and regulations.
