On August 13, 1985, approximately 220 bbls. of oil and 200 bbls. of water were spilled when oil storage tanks located in SE/SE Sec. 1-17S-30E, approximately two miles east and 3-1/2 miles north of Loco Hills, New Mexico, ran over due to a malfunction in the water dump valve on a 4' X 20' heater treater. Immediate notification was given verbally to N.M.O.C.D. in Artesia, New Mexico. None of the spill reached a watercourse. All of the spill soaked into the sand, except + 100 bbls. which were transported to salt water disposal. The area has been graded and backfilled, and no trace of the spill is apparent. #31 well has been shut in, and is suspected of having a water breakin.
