As per approved Sundry Notice of 9/23/86 we proposed the plugging of this well with retention of location and road for replacement well. This was approved on 9/30/86 by Area Manager Charles Dahlen. Subsequent report of abandonment was filed on 2/19/88, and was approved by Shannon Shaw on 3/10/88. This notice also requested retention of location and road for a possible replacement well. Even though the BLM approved both of these Sundry Notices, we received notification by Don Peterson for Barry Hunt on 3/15/88 that when a list of stipulations for final abandonment approval were complied with to notify the BLM. We replied in a letter dated 3/23/88 to Mr. Peterson that we still wanted to retain the location and road for a possible replacement well. We received no further communication on this subject until 2/17/94 when Barry Hunt called and spoke with our Jim Arline and told him that enough time had elapsed and that we needed to now reclaim the location and road (which we did on March 8, 1994) or submit a new APD for the replacement well at today's \$10 per bbl. oil price, which is economically impossible. However, we believe that in the best interests of conservation and economic realities that there should not have been any time considerations placed on the previous approvals as there are no time limits placed on the Operator's final responsibility and liability to properly plug and abandon all wells on the lease at the proper time.

The location and road are ready for final inspection.
