On Nov. 9, 1978, cemented 8-5/8" O.D. 24# K-55 casing at 529' with 300 sacks class "C" cement with 2% CaCl. Cement circulated to surface.

On Nov. 13, 1978, cemented 4 1/2" 9.5# J-55 casing at 3223' with 210 sx. class "C" with .5% CFR-2 and 5# salt/sx. Opened DV tool at 2390' and circulated. On Nov. 16, 1978 cemented thru DV collar with 370 sx. class "H" cement with 10# salt per sx. + 250 sx. class "C" with 2% CaCl + 50 sx. thickset with 2% CaCl. Still had communication. On Nov. 21, 1978, cemented thru DV collar with 250 sx. class "C" with 6% gel and 1/4# flow seal/sx. + 125 sx. class "C" with 3% CaCl. Closed DV tool.

Instructions

General: This form is designed for submitting proposals to perform certain well operations, and reports of such operations when completed, as indicated, on Federal and Indian lands pursuant to applicable Federal law and regulations, and, if approved or accepted by any State, on all lands in such State, pursuant to applicable State law and regulations. Any necessary special instructions concerning the use of this form and the number of copies to be submitted, particularly with regard to local, area, or regional procedures and practices, either are shown below or will be issued by, or may be obtained from, the local Federal and/or State office.

Item 4: If there are no applicable State requirements, locations on Federal or Indian land should be described in accordance with Federal requirements. Consult local State or Federal office for specific instructions.
