

In addition, occasional burned- and fire-cracked caliche cobbles occur in the west-central portion of the pad and border it on the west at a point approximately 125 ft north of its southwestern corner. Remains of this type represent the activities of social units engaged in hunting-related activities and hence are of an en passant nature. Lack of concentration and diagnostic types preclude site designation.

Recommendations

NMAS recommends clearance for General American Oil Company of Texas' Green "B" Well No.9 and its attendant access road and suggests that work-related activities proceed in accordance with company plans.
