Introduction

On 18 April 1979, New Mexico Archaeological Services, Inc., Carlsbad, undertook for General American Oil Company of Texas, Loco Hills, an archaeological reconnaissance of lands administered by the Bureau of Land Management in Eddy County, New Mexico. Reconnoitered areas will be impacted by the construction of a drill location and access road. This project was expedited by Mr. Lendall Hawkins, General American Oil Company of Texas, and Dr. J. Loring Haskell, NMAS. Dr. Haskell conducted the reconnaissance under excellent field conditions.

Survey Technique

For this investigation, the proposed location was examined for evidence of man's past activities by walking it in a series of 20 ft wide, close interval (15° or less), zigzag transects. In addition, an added zone embracing 20 ft on each side of the staked 400 X 400 ft work area, was reconnoitered by a similar means. As for the proposed access road, it was flagged and surveyed by a comparable technique.
