## 4. ROADS

- EXISTING ROADS All existing roads within the immediate area of well site are shown on Exhibit "B".
- PLANNED ROADS 2650' of new road 12' wide will be constructed.
- FENCES, GATES AND CATTLE GUARDS Will be maintained by General American.
- TANK BATTERY If production is encountered Tank Battery will be constructed on location.
- 6. LEASE PIPELINES
  - EXISTING All existing pipelines are shown on Exhibit "B".
  - b. PLANNED If production is encountered, flowline will consist of approximately 100' from well to tank battery on location.
- 7. WASTE DISPOSAL Barrel trash containers will be in accessible locations within the drill site area during the drilling and completion operations. A waste disposal pit will be deep enough to handle waste and will be covered with a minimum of 2 feet of top soil. See Exhibit "C" for pit location. If well is productive, maintenance waste will be placed in special trash cans and hauled away periodically. Any produced water will be disposed of through the currently existing S.W.D. system.
- 8. WATER SUPPLY Water supply to drill this well will be furnished by trucking.
- 9. ARCHAEOLOGICAL RESOURCES - See attached Archaeological Clearance Report.
- RESTORATION OF SURFACE If well is productive, pits will be backfilled and leveled as soon as practical. Upon final abandonment of well, well site 10. will be leveled and cleaned, with land returned as near as possible to original condition.
