Lovington Zone - 3146-3160 - On Feb. 12, 1982, acidized with 1,000 gals. 15%. Broke at 2200 psi. Treated at 2500 psi. @ 3.1 BPM.

Premier Zone - 2997-3034 - On Feb. 18, 1982 acidized with 1,000 gals. 15%. Broke at 3000 psi. Treated at 3000 to 350 psi. Used 76 ball sealers.

On Feb. 23, 1982, re-acidized with 2,000 gals. 15% with 76 ball sealers. Broke at 2000 psi. Treated at 2000 to 2800 psi. at 4.6 BPM.

On Feb. 25, 1982, fraced with 19,000 gals. Western Mini-Max III-30 in 2 stages using 200# rock salt + 100# benzoic acid flakes as diverting plug + 500 gals. acid. Also used 22,000# 20/40 sand and 6,000# 10/20 sand. First stage treated at 3600 psi. at 20 BPM. Second stage treated at 3800 to 4350 psi. at 16 BPM. ISIP - 2200 psi.

Lower Me-Tex Zone - 2899-2911 - On March 2, 1982, acidized with 1500 gals. 15%. Broke at 2100 psi. Treated at 4 BPM at 2100 to 2400 psi.

On March 3, 1982, fraced with 20,000 gals. Mini-Max III-30 + 24,000# 20/40 sand. Treated at 16 BPM at 2250 psi. ISIP - 2200 psi.

Instructions

General: This form is designed for submitting proposals to perform certain well operations, and reports of such operations when completed, as indicated, on Federal and Indian lands pursuant to applicable Federal law and regulations, and, if approved or accepted by any State, on all lands in such State, pursuant to applicable State law and regulations. Any necessary special instructions concerning the use of this form and the number of copies to be submitted, particularly with regard to local, area, or regional procedures and practices, either are shown below or will be issued by, or may be obtained from, the local Federal and/or State office.

Item 4: If there are no applicable State requirements, locations on Federal or Indian land should be described in accordance with Federal requirements. Consult local State or Federal office for specific instructions.

Item 17: Proposals to abandon a well and subsequent reports of abandonment should include such special information as is required by local Federal and/or State offices.
