In conjunction with the form 9-331C, application for permit to drill subject wells, Ray Westall submits the following ten items of pertinent information in a accordance with USGS requirements:

- 1. The Geological surface formation is quaternary.

- 8. Testing, Logging and Coring Program: Logging casing Compensated Neutron and Gamma Ray, Collar Log, Cement Bond Log.
- 9. No abnormal pressures or temperatures are anticipated.
