

1. The first part of the document is a title page. It contains the title "The History of the County of York, from the Earliest Period to the Present Time," and the author's name "By Thomas Wright, Esq." It also includes the publisher's information: "Printed by J. & W. G. Smith, Stationers, in the Strand."

2. The second part of the document is a preface. It begins with the words "I have the honor to acknowledge the assistance of several gentlemen, who have been good enough to read the MS. of this History, and to give me their criticisms and suggestions." It then goes on to state that the author has endeavored to incorporate their remarks into the work, and that he has also consulted several other authorities, including the Rev. Mr. Hall, the Rev. Mr. Thoresby, and the Rev. Mr. Widdows.

3. The third part of the document is a list of contents. It is divided into two columns. The left column lists the chapters, and the right column lists the pages.
