

- F. All trash and debris will be buried or removed from the wellsite within 30 days after finishing drilling and/or completion operations.

8. ANCILLARY FACILITIES:

- A. None required

9. WELL SITE LAYOUT:

- A. The wellsite, surrounded by a 400' X 400' area has been surveyed and flagged.
- B. Dimensions and relative location of the drill pad and pit are shown on Exhibit C.

10. PLANS FOR RESTORATION OF THE SURFACE:

- A. After completion of drilling and/or completion operations, all equipment and other material not needed for operations will be removed. Pits will be filled and the location cleaned of all trash and junk to leave the wellsite in an aesthetically pleasing condition as possible.
- B. Any unguarded pits containing fluids will be fenced until they are filled.
- C. If the well is non-productive the disturbed area will be rehabilitated to surface owner requirements and will be accomplished as expeditiously as possible.

11. OTHER INFORMATION:

- A. Topography: The wellsite and access road are located in the Querecho Plains. The project area drains to the southwest toward Cedar Lake Draw.
- B. Soil: The surface soil is fine sand with caliche and chert inclusions.
- C. Flora and Fauna: Vegetation consists of mesquite, sagebrush, yucca, and various weeds and grasses. Ground cover is about 15%. Wildlife in the area is that typical of semi-arid desert land, such as coyotes, rodents, reptiles and birds.
