On 11/29/94, we perf'd the **Slaughter zone 3761'-3926'** (26 holes). We acidized the perfs 3881'-3926' w/1000 gals of 15% HCl acid. The perfs 3761'-3850' were acidized w/1500 gals 15% HCl acid. The Slaughter zone 3761'-3926' w/48,300 gals gel + 108,000# 20/40 Brady sand + 32,000# resin coated sand.

On 12/31/94, we perf'd the **San Andres zone 3218'-3681'** (15 holes). We acidized the perfs 3536'-3681' w/1200 gals of 15% HCl acid. The perfs 3218'-3355' were acidized w/2175 gals of 15% HCl acid. We frac'd the Upper San Andres zone 3218'-3355' w/29,566 gals gel + 50,500# 20/40 Brady sand + 19,600# resin coated sand.

On 1/13/95, we perf'd the **Grayburg zone 3005'-3171'** (17 holes). We acidized the perfs 3005'-3171' w/1900 gals of 15% HCl acid. The Grayburg zone was frac'd w/43,000 gals gel + 109,000# 20/40 Brady sand + 31,000# resin coated sand.
