Dear Mr. Chumbley:

Reference is made to the following: (i) your application dated July 2, 1999; and (ii) the records of the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division ("Division") in Santa Fe: all concerning Marbob Energy Corporation's ("Marbob") request for an unorthodox infill oil well location within an existing standard 40-acre oil spacing and proration unit comprising the NW/4 SE/4 (Unit J) of Section 17, Township 17 South, Range 30 East, NMPM, Loco Hills-Paddock Pool, Eddy County, New Mexico.

This 40-acre unit is currently dedicated to Marbob's Red Federal Well No. 2 (API No. 30-015-30143) located at a standard oil well location 1650 feet from the South line and 2310 feet from the East line of Section 17.

The application has been duly filed under the provisions of Division 104.F.

By the authority granted me under the provisions of Division Rule 104.F(2), the following described well to be drilled at an unorthodox infill oil well location within the NW/4 SE/4 (Unit J) of Section 17 is hereby approved:

Red Federal Well No. 4 2310' FSL & 1575' FEL (API No. 30-015-30698).

Further, both the existing Red Federal Well No. 2 and the proposed Red Federal Well No. 4 are to be simultaneously dedicated to the subject 40-acre unit.
