MIRU. Weld onto 7" casing. Cut casing at 3,195', could not circulate, re-cut casing at 3,113' and could circulate, but pull 280,000 lbs and could not pull free, re-cut casing at 3024'. Spot 90 sacks cement at 3,244'. Tag plug at 2,854'. Set 150' plug from 716-566' with 50 sacks of cement. Set plug 100' to surface with 30 sacks of cement. Cut off wellhead and installed dry hole marker. RDMO.
