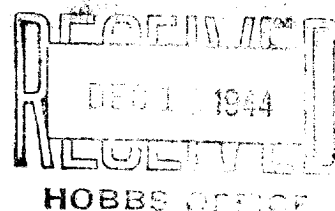

#### DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

The tools were run and went to bottom, the water was tested and sulphur water found in the hole. A bridge was set at 1,000' and 10 sacks of cement placed on this bridge. The hole was then mudded to 650' and a bridge placed at that depth and 10 sacks of cement placed on the bridge. The casing was then pulled and the hole mudded to the surface and a regulation marker was set in cement.
