On February 24, 1969 the above former producing oil well has been converted to water injection per New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission Order R-3671. The following log of operations is submitted for your inspection;

1. Pulled rods and tubing.
2. Cleaned out well bore to 1768' dfm.
3. Ran 36 jts. (1137.50') of 2-3/8" KUX 8rd 4.7# J-55 Plastic lined tubing
4. Set Haliburton 5 1/2" x 2-3/8" "R-3" tension type packer @ 1139' dfm.
5. Filled tubing-casing annulus with 50# Sodium Dichromate mixed in fresh water.
6. Installed injection head. Well on vacuum.
7. Checked annulus after 72 hrs for packer leak. Annulus still full.
Well ready for water injection.

Began water injection in san Andres formation through perfs 1661-72, 1680-98, 1703-08 and 1713-34' on April 1, 1969 at approximately 40 barrels per day.
Well taking water on vacuum.

Instructions

General: This form is designed for submitting proposals to perform certain well operations, and reports of such operations when completed, as indicated, on Federal and Indian lands pursuant to applicable Federal law and regulations, and, if approved or accepted by any State, on all lands in such State, pursuant to applicable State law and regulations. Any necessary special instructions concerning the use of this form and the number of copies to be submitted, particularly with regard to local, area, or regional procedures and practices, either are shown below or will be issued by, or may be obtained from, the local Federal and/or State office.
