Detailed account of work done, nature and quantity of materials used and results obtained.

On June 15, 1956 we sandfracked well, perforating from 1632 to 1657 and from 1664 to 1677, using four shots per foot; treated same with sand frack oil, 15,000# sand and 10,000 gallons of oil.

Work was done by the Dowell Chemical Company.

Well was not tested before fracking. After fracking, well flowed back frack oil at the rate of 16 barrels per hour.

Treating fluid 240 bbls; flush 145 bbls.

On twenty four hour test, well made 60 bbls. after all lead oil was recovered - on 1/4" choke.
