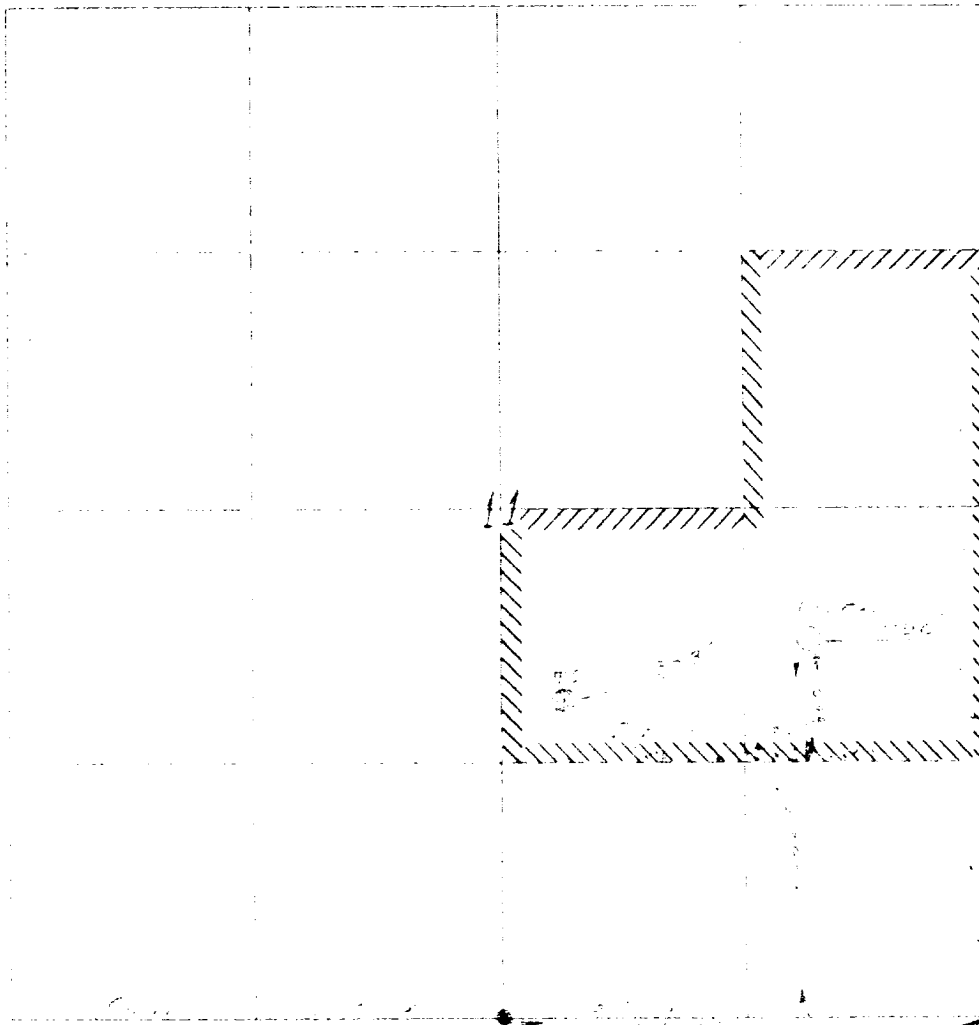

Well Location and/or Gas Proration Plat

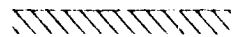
