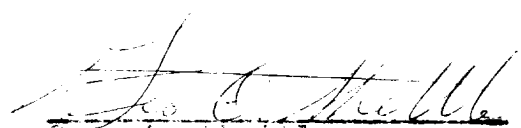
Dear Eleanor:

I received the attached letter from Mr. J. A. Crossett concerning the well at Artesia, N. Mex.

About six months ago I destroyed my file on this particular well and have lost all other information on it. The best I remember, we were allowed to make one perforation (one hole) at a depth of approximately 1200'. We recovered brackish water from this one hole and proceeded to plug according to the commissions regulations. This plugging work was done by Halliburton and all forms were filed with the Water Commission and the Oil & Gas Commission as required at that time.

If you by any chance still have copies of the forms that Mr. Crossett is trying to locate, I would appreciate it if you would forward him copies of them that he asked for in the letter.
