In reply to your letter of September 4, 1956, in which you asked about the development on the Donald Fanning farm. Stanley Jones has a producing oil well in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 14-183-26E. At the time it was completed, they reported it as flowing 50 BOPD, but were able to produce only 39 barrels a day as that is the top allowable as set up by the Proration Office. Whether or not it is producing that much at the present time, I do not know.

Regarding your NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 13-183-26E, there isn't any well as yet.
