ADDITIONAL INFORMATION (If recompletion give full details of proposed plan of work.)

Will run approx. 200' of 13 3/8" casing at surface to shut off surface water, pull when run 8 5/8. We intend to drill to top of Grayburg sand at approx. 950', core grayburg sand. If production is not found will continue to drill to the San Andres, set 8 5/8" pipe through all Artesian aquifer formations, cement & circulate to top. Run 5 1/2" oil string, cement into 8 5/8" pipe 50 feet.

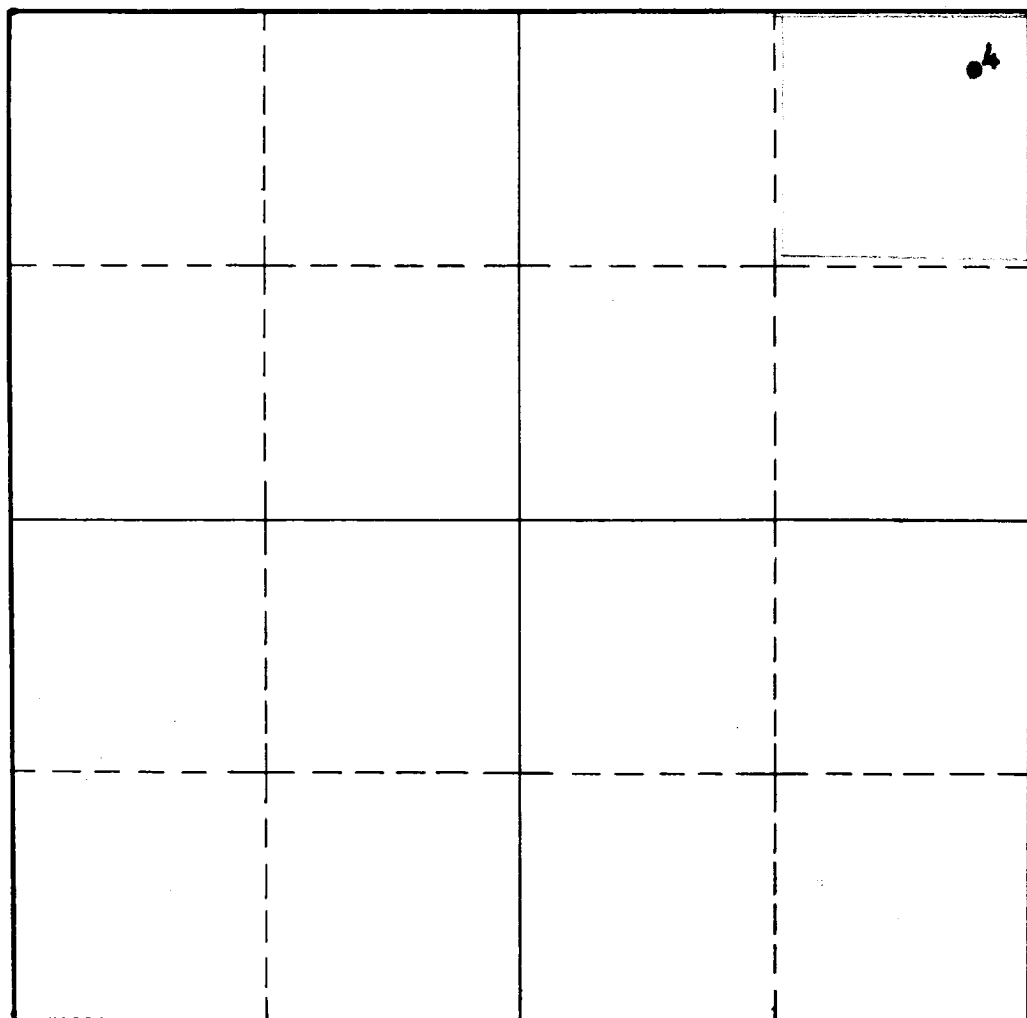

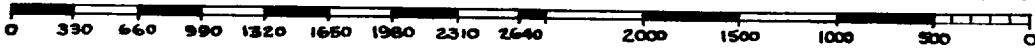
