Will run approximately 200' of 13 3/8 casing at surface to shut off water, pull when run 8 5/8". Will run 8 5/8" through all artesian aquifer formations, cement and circulate to top. Then run 5 1/2" oil string, cement & circulate to surface.

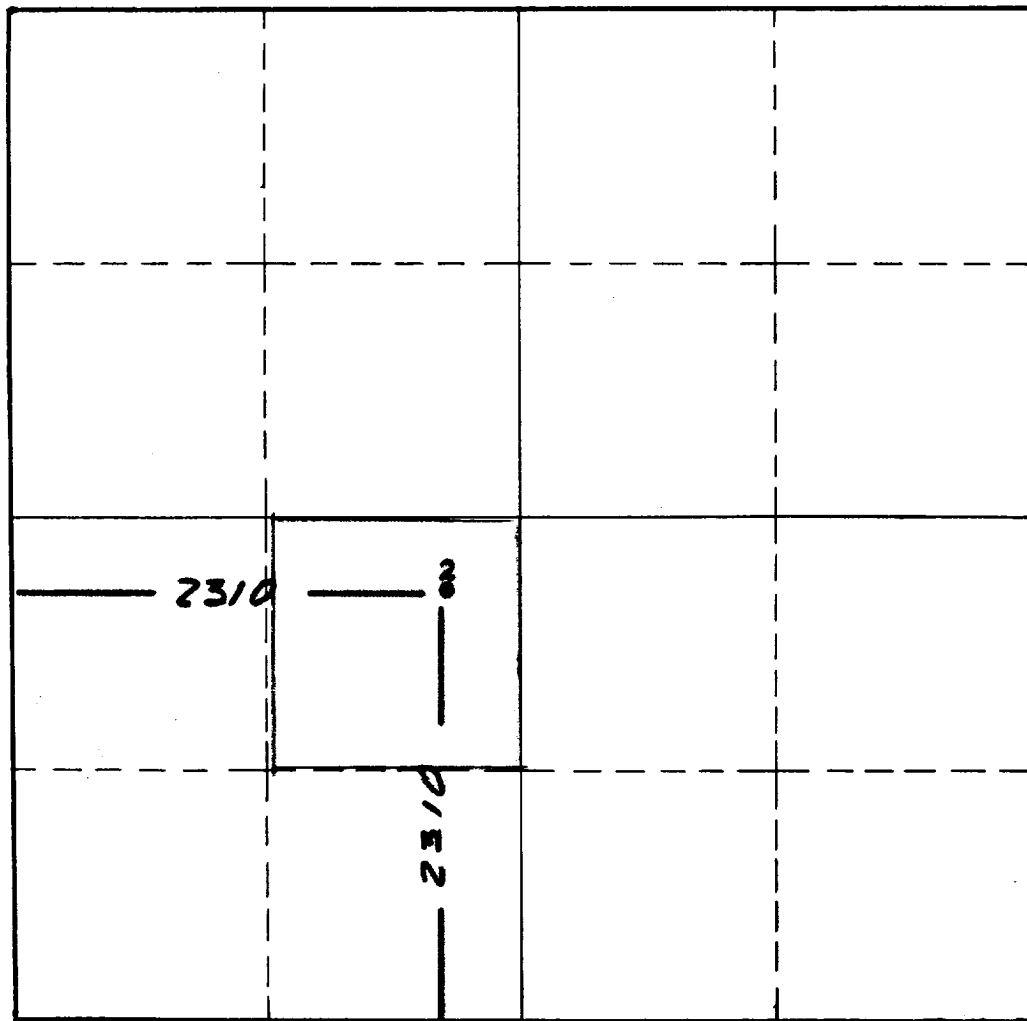
