ADDITIONAL INFORMATION (If recompletion give full details of proposed plan of work.)

Will run Approx. 200' of 13 3/8 casing at surface to shut off surface water, pull when run 8 5/8. We intend to drill to top of Grayburg sand at approx. 950'. Will core grayburg sand. If Grayburg sand is not productive will continue to drill to San Andres. Set 8 5/8 pipe and cement & Circulate to top, through all Garesian aquifer formations. Then run 5 1/2" oil string, cement & circulate to surface.
