DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

Shot well from ¹⁸⁹⁵~~1934~~ to 1984' with 275 quarts of nitroglycerin with first shot; from 1485 to 1710 with 670 quarts of nitroglycerin. 670 quart shot was cemented in hole, but the cement did not set. Shot split pipe and let in sulphur water, but sulphur water has been mudded and cemented off by Halliburton Oil Well Cementing Company. Are letting cement set for 96 hours and then going to test for water shut-off.
