July 29, 1956 - Drilled float & shoe, pressured up to 500 PSI, csg. shut off O.K. Cementing 8 5/8" csg. witnessed by W. A. Gressett w/OCC. Csg. shut off test witnessed by Jim Wright w/State Engineer.
