DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

Heavy mud was run in hole from 1175' to 920' where the 8 1/4" pipe was swung and 15 sacks of cement put in. The 8 1/4" casing was knocked off tow joints up from the bottom and pulled, leaving 41' of pipe in the hole. Heavy mud was put in up to 775' just below the artesian water strata and 25 sacks of cement was put in filling the hole above the water strata at 750'. Heavy mud filled the hole to the base of the cellar and there we cemented the marker. All water was completely shut out and from all appearance, the plugging was complete in every respect.
