DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

As outlined on form C-102 dated October 16th. The well was plugged back to 1800 from a T.D. of 2899. Bottom waters shut off completely. We then shot with 90 q of Nitro from 1140 to 1180 with no results. We then plugged back to 1190 and shot with 240 q of Solidified from 1040-1090. An umbrella was used with 5 car of Col-coal and 35' of Gravel. No results from shot. The well was filled with aquagel and set wooden plug cement with 5 car of cement. The 375' of 7" O.D. Casing was left in well with 12" average and 2" gate valve left on top. Pipe burned, drained
