## DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

Ran cement squeeze job on production string, Halliburton process, tried pumping 50 sacks of cement behind pipe after bridging back from bottom of well with 350 lbs. of lead wool, 50 lbs. of oakum. Approximately 13' of gravel in bottom of hole with lead wool and oakum on top for protection of oil zone. Top of bridgeset at 1084'.
