NE-1/4 of Sec. 35 T. 18 R. 26, N. M. P. M.,  
Dayton Field, EDDY County

**DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED**

The well was shot from 1108' to 1133' with 120 quarts of nitroglycerin and after drilling the bridge out the well showed an increase in gas and oil. Water was coming in from above. A test was run by Halliburton and a split in the 8" casing was found at 4238' down. A squeeze job was run with 100 sacks of cement, let set and plug drilled. A thorough test showed water completely eliminated, leaving hole in first class shape with approximately 25 or 30 barrel well. Completion report follows.
