It is proposed to deepen this well as a wildcat to the Lower Pennsylvanian sand, as found in the Atoka-Pennsylvanian Gas Pool, located one and one-half miles north of this well. The anticipated depth is near 9300 feet. It is proposed to drill a 4-3/4" hole using 4" Hydril Liner to case the additional hole.

Sufficient cement will be used to cover any perforations now existing in the 5-1/2" Casing.
