NOTICE OF INTENTION TO ABANDON WELL

Notice must be given at least five days before work is to begin to the State Geologist or to the proper Oil and Gas Inspector. It is desirable that a representative of the Department of the State Geologist witness the plugging of wells being abandoned whenever possible. If changes in the proposed plan are considered advisable, a copy of this notice showing such changes will be returned to the sender. Submit this notice in duplicate.

You are hereby notified that it is our intention to abandon Terry Well
No. 1 in NW 1/4 of Sec. 15 of Sec. 10 S., T. 10 S., R. 30 E.,
N. M. P. M., Logan Oil Field, 30 County.
We plan to commence work on August 12th, 1927.

The reasons for wishing to abandon the well are as follows:

The present condition of the well is as follows:

The work which we propose to do in abandoning the well is as follows:

To be filled with mud from 3156 to 2160 feet. Will place a wooden plug, salt water, sand and one above sand at about 2100 feet and cement with five sacks using one gal. konset and leave set 24 hours. At the end of this time will continue to fill hole with mud to 1600 ft. Place wooden plug and mud to 1300 ft. Place wooden plug and five sacks of cement and leave stand 24 hours. At the end of this time if there is no gas escaping will ripp 8 1/2" casing at 1147 above cement and pull ripp 10" casing at 997 above cement and pull leaving 12 1/2" casing in the hole. (9)
