1. That he is Area Supervisor of Chevron Oil Company

2. That Chevron Oil Company is the operator of a well drilled on land be-

longing to Wendell Welch, whose address is Rt. 1, Box 74A  
(Landowner)  
Artesia, New Mexico, said well being drilled to test for hydrocarbons and/or carbon dioxide gas and described as the Paul Terry Unit No. 1, being located 1980 feet from the North line and 1980 feet from the West line of Section 15, Town-ship 18 S, Range 26 E, NMPM, Eddy County, New Mexico.
3. That said well was drilled to a total depth of 9100 feet, and that casing has been set and cemented as follows:  
10 3/4" casing at 1288'

4. That operator and landowner have made an agreement to transfer said well to landowner for use as a water well, and that operator and landowner agree that operator has back-filled pits, leveled location and cleared it of all junk, and that well is presently properly plugged. Operator has left casing in the well as follows.

10 3/4" casing cemented at 1288'.

5. That operator has complied with the provisions of Paragraph 4 above, has notified the Oil Conservation Commission of the State of New Mexico on Commission Forms C-103 covering operations to plug on October 20, 1958 through October 30, 1958 and further operations on April 11 and 12, 1960. That operator will file a copy of this affidavit, with signed statement from landowner below that provisions of Paragraph 4 above have been complied with to his satisfaction.
